The Electoral Roll

St Luke's Church has an official list of named participants called an electoral roll. The electoral roll is the list of those who want to be involved with a particular ecclesial community associated with the Church of England. Putting your name on the roll is a way of saying 'I belong'; it is an act of commitment to a particular spiritual community and also to the wider Church. It is an important statement of witness, and step along the path of discipleship. Being on the electoral roll entitles you to vote at annual and monthly Moot Community Council Meetings.

Having your name on the electoral roll does not carry any obligations but you do need to be baptized, attend moot events and activities and be over 16 years of age. You may be on the electoral rolls of two ecclesial communities associated with the Church of England.
