Statement of Significance

1) Section 1. Brief history and description of the church building(s), contents, churchyard and setting

The current Church building of St Luke's was built in the 1950s after the area was bombed. More recently the development of the North Peckham Estate afforded the reorganisation of the churchyard, to include a carpark and a new Church Hall. The Church Hall and Church and carpark and grounds are all sited between CHandler Way and Pentridge Street SE15. The Church is Listed Grade II.
