

Electoral Officer Report by Sandra Douglas

At the APCM in March 2017 there were 104 on the electoral roll, with approximately 5 people leaving in that year. As of 21st April 2018 there are now 113 members of the electoral roll. All those who are admitted to the electoral roll either have to attend services regularly for six months if they live outside of the parish, or those who are able to join immediately if they live within the parish. All those admitted to the Electoral Roll have completed and signed an electoral roll form which is stored securely in paper form in the Church office and password protected in e-form on the Church Dropbox Internet Server. The growth in the electoral roll is attributed to a growing congregation in the Sunday Evening Service, and a few new people joining the Sunday Morning Service.

In some parishes, there are some members on the electoral roll who do not habitually attend Sunday Services at least once a month. The vast majority of those on the Electoral Roll of St Luke's Church attend services regularly, at least once a month.
