

Church Wardens Report, St. Luke's APCM 29TH APRIL 2018

Mrs Yemi Ojumu and Mrs Joy Russell were re-elected as church wardens 9th April 2017.

Archdeacon Service at Southwark Cathedral was 16th May 2017

Work done up to date for 2017.

Portable Appliance Test on electrical appliances are up to date.

Woodworm infestation noticed during the Architect visit in July 2016 is now under control. Thanks to the Architect advice that instead of paying large sum of money to pest control company we should buy wood worm solution from DIY shop and treat it ourselves. This is what the churchwardens has undertake in doing. So far there are no evidence of woodworm in the pews. This is on-going we endeavour to keep on top of this problem. The poisonous Japanese knot weed, there is no evidence of its return by the space outside the hall to the side of Pentridge street. Two trees were planted in the church yard on the side to Pentridge street. Yearly service to Gas heater and yearly service Fire extinguishers has been done. Awaiting Hall Gas boiler yearly service due in May 2018.

Repairs on windows – 2 window panes replaced due to damage by pellet. Reported to the police. One leaded window repaired in the Bell tower and one stained leaded light window in the church as you enter the church to your left, two pews damaged due to woodworm both thrown in the big bin. 17th Dec 2017 electricity failure and gas occurred this was eventually put right by the Power emergency service on the 21st Dec 2017. Drainpipes and gutters for the church and hall was cleared of leaves and other debris three times during the period of 2017.

6th Sept.2017 the Licensing of Revd. Sandra Schloss took place here at St Luke's church. On the 24th Sept 2017 ordination of Revd. Collin Dureke took place also at St Luke's church
